To all Lawgic Subscribers Using Microsoft Word

Some of our customers are experiencing a "hidden text" formatting display issue when creating Lawgic documents using Word. This is an issue in Word that we cannot control from the Lawgic program, but there is a quick and easy fix.

Symptom: Your Word document will display the following formatting after each provision heading:

1.1 For My Benefit

. The Trustees shall pay to or apply for my benefit (without obligation to any guardian who may be appointed for me) whatever income or principal that the Trustees in their discretion deem necessary or advisable for my best interests.

Solution: With the Lawgic document displayed on the screen in Word click the **Tools** menu in Word and then click **Options**. On the **View** tab be sure the **'hidden text'** box is unchecked. The provision should now look like this:

1.1 For My Benefit. The Trustees shall pay to or apply for my benefit (without obligation to any guardian who may be appointed for me) whatever income or principal that the Trustees in their discretion deem necessary or advisable for my best interests.

You may have to uncheck the 'hidden text' box the next time you open the document.
