



NETWORK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This uses the network to share Lawgic answer, template and flag files. The Lawgic program itself is installed on each individual's workstation as well as the server.

1. Install Lawgic to the network server. Important: Java Runtime Environment (JRE) will be installed. Please see, Supplemental Software Installation Information.

If installing a product update: If you already have Lawgic installed on a network and are simply installing a product update, we suggest you make a backup copy of the lawgic.ini file located in the Windows (or WINNT) folder of each workstation BEFORE installing the update since the update install process overwrites the existing lawgic.ini file. This will insure that you have a copy of your current lawgic.ini configuration for reference.

2. Note the drive letter and folder on the server where you choose to install Lawgic (this is the server path). Be sure to give users 'read' and 'write' access to the subfolders of the server path.
3. Install Lawgic to each user's workstation. Note the drive letter and folder where you choose to install Lawgic (this is the local path).
4. On each workstation map a network drive to the Lawgic folder on the server. (Use the server path. i.e. \\servername\C:\Program Files\Lawgic). You should use the same drive letter on each workstation for ease of administration.
5. Next, find the lawgic.ini file in the Windows folder (C:\Windows or C:\WINNT) of each user's workstation and open it in Notepad or any word processor. Change the line beginning with the word "shared" found in the [PATH] section so that the path specified is the server path from step 1, and not the local path. Be sure to save the file in text format. This change must be made to each user's lawgic.ini file. An example of a lawgic.ini file that provides the ability to run from individual workstations follows:

```
[PATH]
local=C:\PROGRA~1\LAWGIC
temp=C:\PROGRA~1\LAWGIC
program=C:\PROGRA~1\LAWGIC
shared=H:\
```

H:\ is representing the mapped drive letter you chose in step 4. This will differ depending on what letter you used for your mapped drive.

Important: In the Lawgic program the Open Answer File dialog box will show a "Shared" box. By default, the box will be "checked" which means that answer files are opened from the Shared folder. When you uncheck the box, the answer file will be opened from the Local folder on your computer. If you select Save or Save As from the File menu, your answer file will automatically be saved to the Shared folder on the network.

** SUPPLEMENTAL SOFTWARE INSTALLATION INFORMATION **

- JAVA RUN-TIME ENVIRONMENT

You must have administrative rights on the workstation and/or server to install Java.

The program requires the installation of Java Runtime Environment (JRE) on each workstation that is to run Lawgic. This is a 1-time install. The installation wizard will automatically detect whether you already have the correct JRE installed and will install it for you if necessary.

To download the JRE from our website at <http://www.lawgic.com/support/downloads.html>, should you need it. Simply click on SUPPORT, then DOWNLOADS. It is also available on the Lawgic CD, if you have one.

- RUNNING LAWGIC ON WINDOWS XP AND WINDOWS 2003 NETWORK

All users of Lawgic must have full control rights to the Javasoft folder and to the Lawgic folder. These folders are both respectively located by default in the program files folder.

Example:

C:\Program Files\Javasoft

and

C:\Program Files\Lawgic
